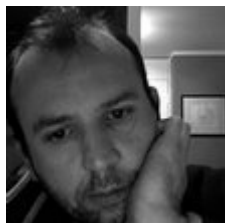

He wrote and created the cult hit *World of Pub* starring Peter Serafinowicz, Kevin Eldon and Phil Cornwall.

Tony has also written and directed an award-winning short film *How to Tell When a Relationship is Over*.
